


**Sing praise to the LORD, you saints of His,

# What they learned

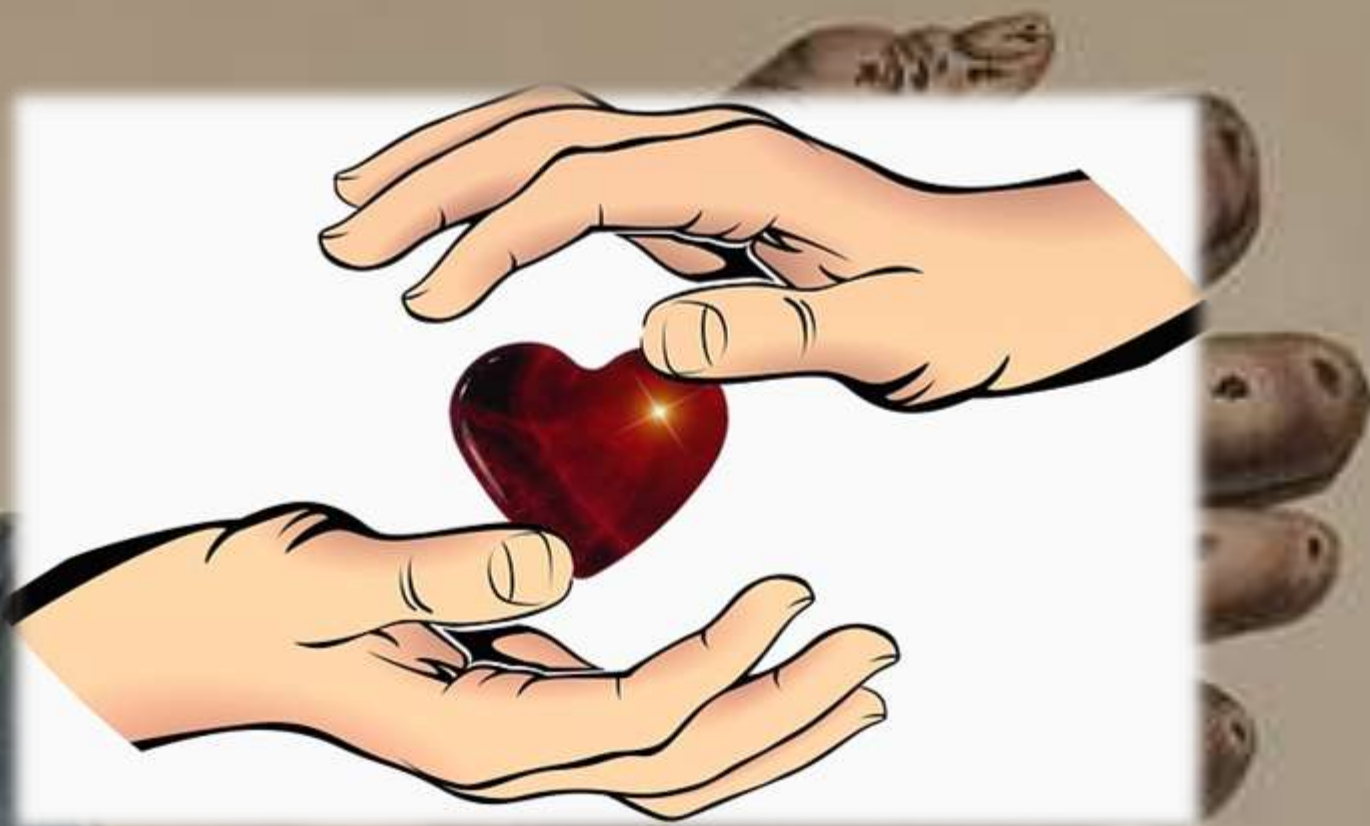
- The nine: Mercy for those who seek Him
