The Context

Jesus' question, Peter's answer v18-20

Jesus prepares them for His death v21-22

Jesus prepares them for their death v23-27



The Events v28-36

Jesus takes Peter, James, and John

Jesus is changed (Mt. 17:1; Mk. 9:3)

Jesus, Moses, and Elijah (Mt. 5:17; 7:12;
Mt. 11:13; 22:40; 1 Pet. 1:10-12)

Peter's suggestion (Mk. 9:6)

God's reply (Mt. 17:5-8)

Years later, Peter reflects 2 Pet. 1:16-18

Lessons

1. Be convicted, not merely amazed

Jn. 20:30-31; Mt. 28:18-19;

1 Cor. 1:2; Mt. 16:18

Lessons

2. Dishonoring Jesus (*not knowing what he said*)

God's memorial of Jesus' resurrection is to assemble on the first day of the week (Mk. 16:9; Acts 20:7; Rev. 1:10)
