 "And by the way, if you can find what we in science call a second genesis — this is to say, did life start another way on the earth — there are researchers at Astrobiology Institute, researchers supported by NASA, your tax dollars, that are looking for answers to that very question. Is it possible that life could start another way? Is there some sort of life form akin to science fiction that's crystal instead of membranous?
