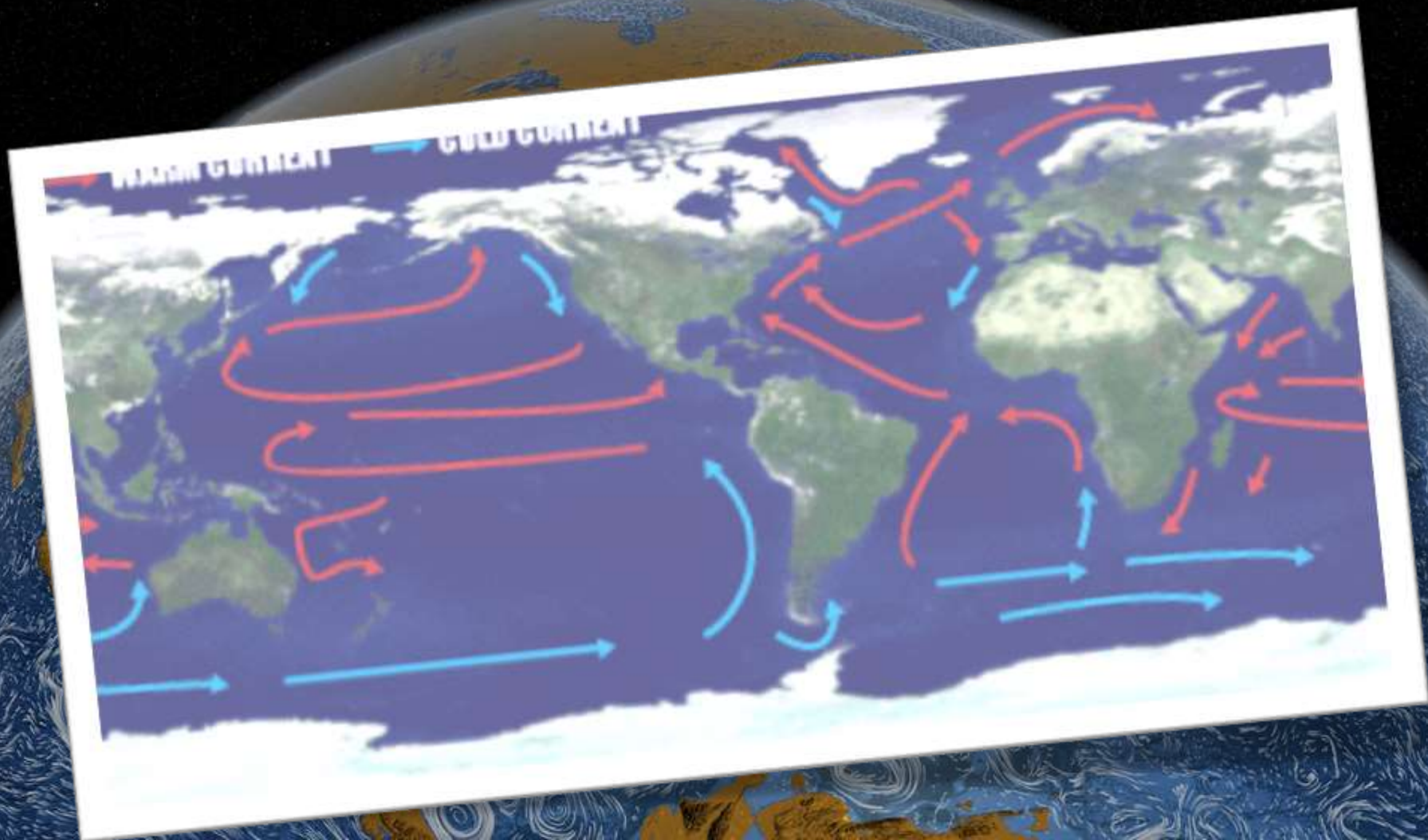
“Its eyes observe from afar”

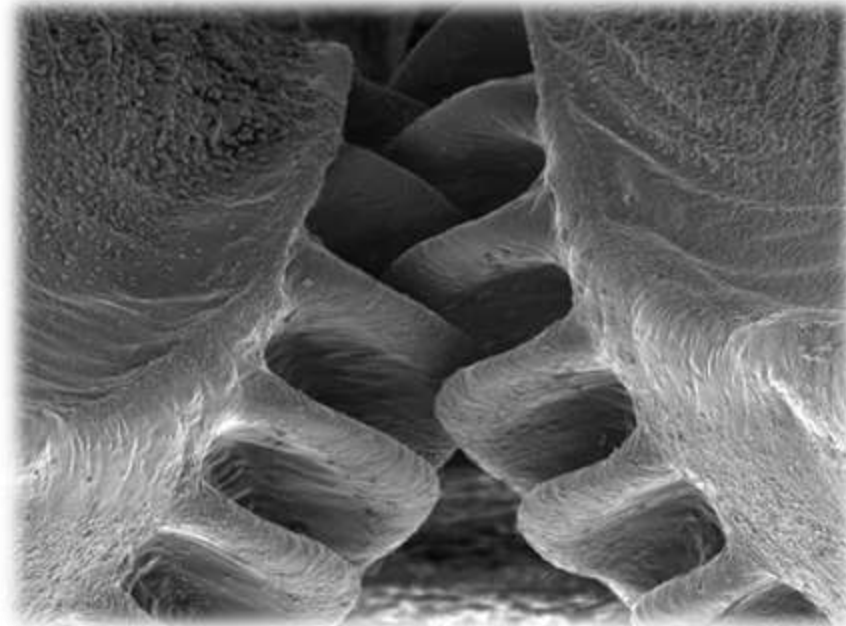
