# Jesus' response helps us to see

## 1. Righteous versus Self-righteous

Who does Jesus not call to repent:

men who never sinned? Rom. 3:23

men God has made righteous? Lk. 1:6

men who see no need for help? Mt. 23:28

We can be righteous Rom. 5:19; 1 Jn. 3:4, 7;  
Mt. 25:46
